

# PET OWNERSHIP

## Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw No. 13 of 2021



There are a number of regulations that provide for a safe and healthy environment for people and their pets.

Fines vary depending on the nature of the violation:

- 🐾 Failure to license a cat or dog or failure to attach a valid license when off your property.  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Dog or cat being at large.  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Dog or cat feces must be removed immediately from public or private property (other than the pet owner's property).  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Allowing animal feces to accumulate on the pet owner's property.  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence

To report any of the above violations, contact Prince Albert SPCA Animal Control Services at (306) 981-6115.

- 🐾 Leaving a cat or dog unattended in a vehicle.  
\$100 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Dogs or cats must not chase, threaten or injure people or other animals.  
\$100 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Exceeding the maximum number of animals. 5 cats and dogs in total, with a max of 3 dogs.  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
- 🐾 Dog or cat barking or howling.  
\$75 – 1<sup>st</sup> Offence
