Led by George Glenn, "Understanding Acrylic Media" is a two-day workshop which will introduce a variety of media used by acrylic painters. It will explain the use of media such as GAC, gesso, matt and gloss medium, tar gel and retarder, and provide an opportunity to experiment with these media on paper, canvas, and wood.

Participants are not required to have experience with acrylics, but will have to bring a few basic supplies. A full class list will be provided before the workshop. (Registrants can pick up a supply list at the Arts Centre.)

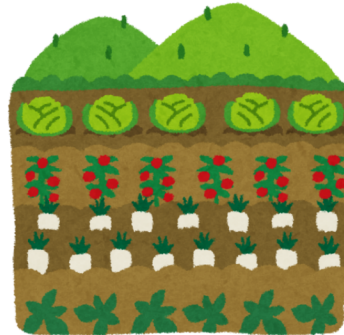

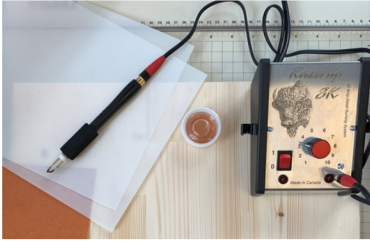

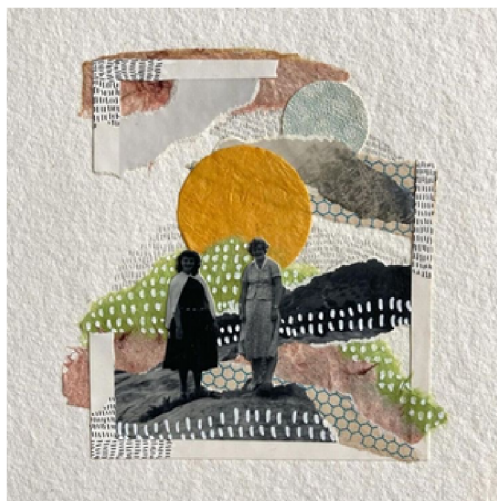

Studio	Capacity 75 ppl, upstairs, large open room with skylight, includes chairs and tables.
