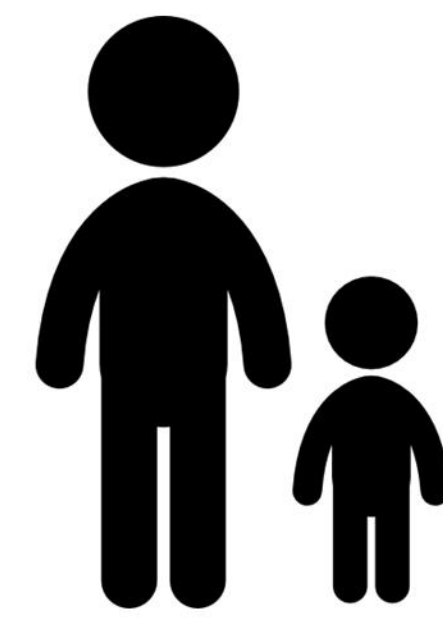


RULES AND REGULATIONS

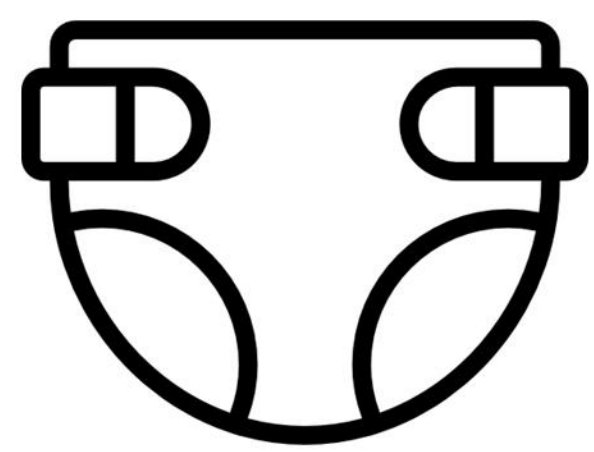
PLEASE READ AND OBEY ALL POSTED RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS.



Swimmers must take a cleansing shower before entrance to any pool.



One adult can watch a maximum of 3 children under the age of 8.



Children, and anyone who is or may be incontinent, should wear protective swim diapers..



Diving is not permitted in the main pool. Diving is allowed in the deep tank.



Patrons with a communicable disease or open sores shall not enter any pool.



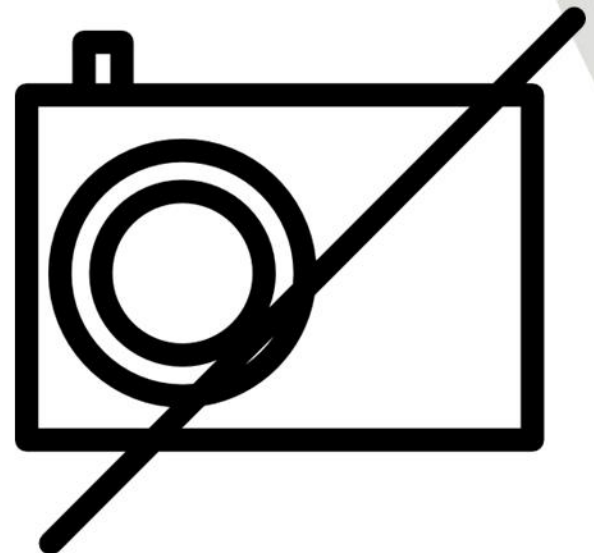
Caution to expectant mothers while in hot tub and on diving boards.



Smoking is not permitted.



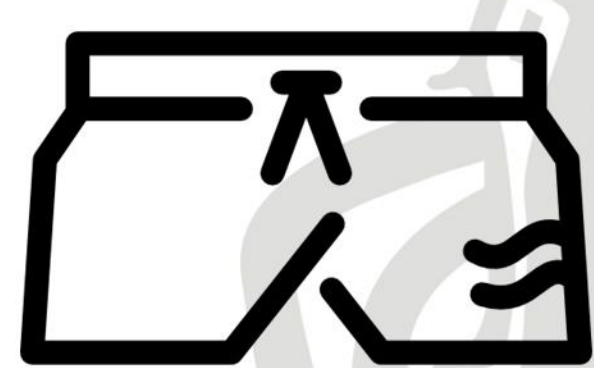
Glass containers are not permitted within the pool or change room areas.



Recording devices (cell phones, cameras) are not permitted within any change room or toilet facilities.



Patrons under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted within the facility.



Proper swim attire must be worn. No undergarments. Cotton is not permitted.



Patrons should disclose any medical conditions they may have to aquatic staff upon arrival.



Those with high blood pressure or heart conditions should consult with their physician before hot tub use.



Littering is not permitted. Food and drink is not permitted on the pool deck.



Only service dogs are allowed in the waterpark. Pets are not allowed.



Running and boisterous play is not permitted.

All children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult (at least 18 years of age) within arms' reach at all times while at the Frank J. Dunn Swimming Pool.
